## Behavior Covenant —

**Somerset Community Garden promises** to provide a fenced garden plot, along with access to water. In addition, the Community Garden will provide the opportunity for gardeners to learn and grow in their gardening skills. The Community Garden will also provide space & time to create and maintain friendships with other members of the Community Garden, as well as opportunities for service to our neighbors.

## To assist with this community endeavor, I promise:

- I will pay an annual fee of \$25 to help cover garden expenses.
- I will have something planted in the garden by June 1st and keep it planted all summer long, otherwise forfeit my plot
- I will clear my garden plot of all plant material, tools and garden implements by October 31.
- If I do not clean your plot by the end of the season, I cannot renew my plot next year
- I will respect the garden's hours of operation: Monday through Saturday, 7am to dusk; Sunday, 12pm to dusk.
- I will **not plant** any illegal plants, any trees or shrubs, any perennials, or strawberries, sweet potatoes, ginger, garlic, asparagus, rhubarb, or berries
- I will keep weeds at a minimum and maintain the areas immediately surrounding my plot.
- I will not use industrial/artificial pesticides, fungicides, or weed repellents. I will assure that any fertilizer I use will not affect any other plots.
- If I must abandon my plot for any reason, I will notify the garden leadership. If my plot becomes unkempt, I understand I will be given 2 weeks' notice to clean it up. At that time, it will be re-assigned.
- I will keep trash and litter out of the plot, as well as from adjacent pathways and fences.
- I will not use fencing or other garden edging/dividers taller than 18 inches in my garden plot.
- I will plant tall crops where they will not shade neighboring plots, arranging bean poles and trellises along an east/west line rather than north/south, in order to preserve my neighbors' access to sunshine.
- I will pick only my own crops unless given permission by another gardener.
- I will not waste water by leaving a running hose unattended. I will conserve resources by watering only in the early morning or late afternoon/evening on high temperature days.
- I agree to volunteer a portion of my time toward the Community Garden, in particular, **Garden Work Days**, the **Spring Opening** (First Saturday in May) & the **Fall Clean-up & Closing** (Last Saturday in October).
- If I bring my children and grandchildren to the garden, I will supervise them at all times.
- I will not bring pets to the garden (service animals are exempt).
- I will not smoke in the garden, or bring or consume alcohol or illegal substances on the entire site, including the parking lot.
- I will respect the other members of the Community Garden, and will seek to love my neighbor at all times through my words and actions by speaking honestly and respectfully to one another, and by dealing openly with disagreements or disputes as they may arise.
- I will contact the Community Garden coordinator before April 10 to confirm whether I would like to continue for another year. I understand that, if the coordinator does not hear from me, she will assume I am not interested in another year of community gardening, and my plot may be offered to the next gardener on the waiting list.
